Harroddian is celebrating its best ever A Level results and an impressive increase in top grades at GCSE along with strong average point scores (APS) across both year groups, reports Headmaster James Hooke.

“71% of all our GCSE grades were 9-7 (the old A*/A grades), up from 67% last year. Two pupils scored ten straight 9 grades and thirteen others scored a combination of 9s and 8s (the old A* star grade).”

“At A Level, our proportion of A*/A grades jumped to 52% against 49% in 2018. When factoring in B grades, the success of our pupils is further demonstrated by an impressive 80% of all grades hitting A*/A/B.”




Above: Angelica and Sonya both scored ten straight 9s in their GCSEs.

Above: Our outgoing Head Girl, Nicole, and Head Boy, Zac, celebrate three A*s and four As between them.


- 71% of all Harroddian GCSE results hit the top three grades of 9-7 (the old A*/A grades) up from 67% last year
- Two Harroddian pupils, above, (out of 837 nationwide) scored ten straight 9s
- Thirteen others scored a combination of 9s and 8s
- Of the 95 GCSE students, 97% achieved grades between 9-5

- 52% of all Harroddian A Level results hit the top A*/A mark against 49% in 2018
- 80% of all grades A*/A/B
- One student, a homegrown Harroddian from the age of four, scored an extraordinary four A*s
- 29 students attained at least one A* and 28 achieved the equivalent of three As or better
