Activities extend far beyond the classroom. Over a dozen different art clubs take place in the School every week, from textiles to ceramics. Students participate in both school and public competitions, including Young Art and the Royal Academy Young Artists' Summer Show.

Artist talks and visits take place throughout the school year across every age group. We also arrange regular art trips to galleries in London such as Frieze, to artists' studios and centres of design and craft excellence, and to overseas destinations and events including the Venice Biennale.
