HEADLINES

- 68% of all grades achieved by our Harrodian Upper Sixth were either grade A* or A
- 5 students achieved straight A*s (17 A*s between them) and 41 achieved all A* or A grades (44%)
- 94% of Harrodian A Level students succeeded in entering their first-choice or insurance offer university in the UK, USA, Canada or Europe and 16 of them will be taking a gap year/deferred entry
- 84% accepted their first-choice universities
- Approximately 71% of UK University destinations are Russell Group Universities
- 9% of students going to university are studying abroad: IE University Madrid (x5), New York University (x2) and Boston University (x1) in USA and University of Toronto (x1), Canada
- Most popular UK destinations: University of Bristol (x11), University of Edinburgh (x9), Durham University (x6), University of Bath (x6), University of Exeter (x5), The University of Manchester (x 5), Loughborough University (x 4), and University College London (x 4)
- Most popular subject areas for degree (UK): Medicine/Science/STEM including Mathematics and Engineering (x 19), Business/Economics/Management/Finance (x 18), Psychology / Philosophy (x7), and Sport Management/Coaching/Exercise Science (x7), History/Politics/International Relations/Law (x 7)
