

At Harrodian, we prioritise the development of leadership and teamwork as key life skills and provide our pupils with a wide and diverse range of opportunities to take responsibility as they progress through the School.

Our integrated Leadership Programme enables pupils to support and facilitate all areas of school life, with a range of leadership positions on offer. Harrodians can serve on Student Councils, mentor younger pupils and work as subject, community and sports leaders. In the Senior School, many prefect roles are available, as well as the key positions of Head Boy/Head Girl, their Deputies and Head of Mentoring.

Involvement in schemes such as the Youth Philanthropy Initiative (YPI), The Duke of Edinburgh's Award and team-building activities/residential trips (such as Coastalcraft and Ardèche) also form an essential ingredient in the Harrodian leadership skills mix.
