PREP DRESS CODE Years 4 – 8 (8s to 12s) Clothing List

Tops

- Shirt or blouse **with collar and sleeves**, to cover entire midriff (not see-through or short, not tied-up).
- Only white T-shirts may be worn underneath shirts (no base layers); shirts must be buttoned up.
- White shirt with collar for special occasions (e.g. school photo).
- Smart plain jumper or cardigan no pictures/print. Discreet logos only.
- School hooded top (optional) no other hooded tops permitted.
- Coats/jackets with hoods may only be worn outdoors i.e. before or after school, during break and lunchtimes.

Bottoms

- Smart dark trousers/tailored shorts.
 - dark trousers must be loose fitting, tailored school trousers.
- **No jeans.** No leggings / jeggings permitted.
- Smart dark skirt, which must rest at appropriate length above the knee or longer.
- No denim allowed

Tights and Shoes

- Navy, grey or black tights (no patterns).
- Socks must be worn if not wearing tights
- Smart dark leather or suede shoes or ankle boots only. The visible sole of the shoe must likewise be dark.
- Only in medical circumstances will alternative footwear be considered. If your child attends the Foot Health Service and requires a specific shoe type/fitting, please supply a letter from them to support your request for your child to wear alternative footwear.

Not permitted:

Faded trousers
Jeans/ no denim
Cargo pants
Leggings or jeggings of any type
Skinny fit trousers
Uggs or similar style boots
Canvas shoes e.g. Vans, Converse
Boots (except ankle boots)

Trainers e.g. Nike Airforce shoes Heels

All items of clothing must be clearly labelled.

JEWELLERY AND MAKE-UP

Discreet jewellery is permitted (at the discretion of the Head of Year). Earrings: pupils may wear one pair of small earrings, only one earring in each ear. Make-up and nail polish are not permitted.

HAIR

Hair must not be extreme in style or length. Hair must not be dyed and <u>only plain, functional</u> <u>hair accessories are allowed.</u>

BAGS

Bookbag / rucksack - no restriction on colour or design
