Pupil Safety Policy

The safety and well-being of our pupils is of paramount importance at Harrodian. The staff encourage responsible behaviour within the School and try to allow pupils to be self-regulating in this respect.

Our documentation frequently includes the following statement: *Harrodian aims to provide a safe and secure environment for all School community members and maintain high standards of behaviour, care and control so that every pupil has the right to enjoy learning free from intimidation, both inside and outside the classroom.*

Pupil safety is ensured and monitored on the school site, during normal school hours, during after-school activities and on school-organised (and supervised) off-site activities and trips.

Below is a list of some of the ways in which pupils' safety is ensured:

- High levels of staff duties before and after school and during morning breaks and lunch.
- Onsite Security Team during operational school hours.
- Onsite Medical Team of School Nurses and additional first aid trained staff members during operational school hours.
- CCTV in key places over the School site.
- PSHRE sessions, including talks on drugs, mobile use, personal safety, alcohol consumption, etc.
- Road safety instruction and cycling proficiency.
- The completion of a risk assessment for any school event and educational trips.
